

AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE THE PARKING OF MOTOR VEHICLES IN THE TOWN OF FAYSTON, VERMONT

IT IS HEREBY ENACTED AND ORDINATED BY THE BOARD OF SELECTMEN OF THE TOWN OF FAYSTON, VERMONT AS FOLLOWS:

SEC. 1—Definitions:

As used herein the following terms shall have the following meanings:

- a) "Highway" means all of the usually traveled parts of any bridge, culvert, roadway, street, square or a way laid out under the authority of law;
- b) "Motor vehicles" means all vehicles propelled or drawn by power other than muscular power;
- c) "Park" means to leave a motor vehicle upon any highway with no one in the driver's seat, or place usually occupied by the operator of said motor vehicle.

SEC. 2—No motor vehicle shall be parked upon a highway within the Town of Fayston, during the calendar period from November 1st to April 1st.

SEC. 3—Any person who violates Sec. 2 of this ordinance shall be fined not more than \$25.00 (Twenty-five) in addition to any other penalties, charges or cost hereinunder assessed.

SEC. 4—Any motor vehicle parked on a highway of the Town of Fayston, in violation of the provisions of Sec. 2 of this Ordinance, when in the opinion of any law enforcement officer, the public safety demands its immediate removal or when in the opinion of the road commissioner the proper plowing, maintenance or repair of said highway requires its immediate removal, may be removed forthwith on order of said law enforcement officer, or road commissioner. All costs of said removal and any expense incurred in securing such motor vehicle shall be charged against the owner of said motor vehicle or the person responsible for said motor vehicle at the time removal is ordered and said motor vehicle shall not be released to the owner or person responsible for it at the time removal was ordered until all such costs have been paid.

SEC. 5—Should any section or provision of this ordinance be held to be invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, its invalidity shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or any part thereof other than the portion as held to be invalid.

This ordinance shall take effect from the 20th day of December, 1964.

Approved at Fayston, this 15th day of December, 1964, by due motion and vote of the Board of Selectmen of the Town of Fayston, Vermont.
