RE: AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE PIPES AND TRANSMISSION LINES
IN THE TOWN OF FAYSTON, VERMONT

All pipes and transmission lines crossing beneath the Town of Fayston Highways shall be buried to a depth of not less than four feet within the highway limits.

All water and power lines shall have a protective sleeve for the full width of the Town Highway Right of Way.

A complete and detailed record of all lines as to Depth, Placement, and Type of Material, shall be filed within ten days from completion of installation with the Fayston Town Clerk.

Unless the above Regulations have been complied with, the Town of Fayston assumes no responsibility for damage to any of the above mentioned lines.

This Ordinance shall take effect from the 25th day of January, 1968.

Approved at Fayston, Vermont this 23rd day of January, 1968, by due motion and vote of the Board of Selectmen of the Town of Fayston, Vermont.
